LITHUANIAN YOUTH BOULDERING CHAMPIONSHIP 2019 REGULATIONS



Aims:

- To increase the visibility of sport climbing in Lithuania. To promote bouldering competitions.
- To implement the most important climbing competition for youth and children – Lithuanian youth bouldering championships and find out the strongest athletes in five age groups.
- To select the strongest youth athletes of Lithuania and to create the National Youth climbing team, which will represent Lithuania in international competitions.

Date: 4th of May, 2019 (Saturday). Beginning of registration: 10:00. Start of first group 10:40.

Place: Rock climbing center „Scala Dream“, Mainų g. 6, Klaipėda, Lithuania.

Organizers: Lithuanian Federation of Sport Climbing and „Scala Dream“. Routsetters - Mikhail Kochetkov, Artūras Volkovas.

Competitors:

All Lithuanian and foreign athletes born in 2000 and younger are welcome to compete. Each foreign club can participate with 4 athletes (4 girls/4 boys) in each age group.

The competition takes place between girls and boys in five age groups:

- Youth A group – born in 2000 – 2001 y.
- Youth B group – born in 2002 – 2003 y.
- Youth C group – born in 2004 – 2005 y.
- Youth D group – born in 2006 – 2007 y.
- Youth E group – born in 2008 y. and younger

Registration & fees: The athletes can register in advance until 1st of May 2019 (day included) by sending filled registration form to email dmitrij@scaladream.com. Price: 7 € starting fee + 6 € LLSF license fee (the ones who doesn't have license yet). Climbers should have health certificates and be familiar with rules of safe climbing.

Referees and rules: The competition is executed based on Vilnius, Kaunas and Klaipėda's climbing clubs' agreed terms and regulations of "2019 Lietuvos jaunimo boulderingo čempionato taisyklės" (You can find the rules and regulations (LT) online: www.climbing.lt) and additional conditions and rules, agreed during the event.

- There are 10 boulders at the youth A, youth B and youth C groups qualification.
- There are 14 boulders at the youth D and youth E groups qualification-final round.
- Finals are held only for youth A, youth B and youth C groups. In case of same results among competition winners in youth D and youth E groups, mini-super-finals can be held.
- The final stage is carried out if at least 5 participants of one sex are involved in qualification. Otherwise (in the case of four or less participants of one sex) the final stage is not organized and qualification results are counted as final results.
- Finals are held at IFSC semi-finals format – climbers has 5 boulders and 5 minutes for each.
- All results are calculated based on the number of tops and zones and tries.

Provisional timetable:

10:00 – 10:30 – registration;

10:40 – 12:00 youth C group (2004-2005) qualification;

~12:15 – 13:25 youth A group (2000-2001) and youth B group (2002-2003) qualification;

~13:40 – 15:10 youth D group (2006-2007) qualification;

~15:20 – 16:40 youth E group (2008 and younger) qualification;

~17:10 youth A, youth B and youth C groups, girls climbs first, ~17:30 boys finals;

~19:45 – awards ceremony

Timetable will be posted after the end of the pre-registration!

The winners in each group will be awarded as soon as the official each group results are announced.

Awards: 1-3 places in each age group are awarded for both, boys and girls. Also, 1-3 places are awarded for Lithuanian youth bouldering champions, boys and girls, separately.
